ADHD TESTING AND DIAGNOSIS

At HCC, ADD & AD/HD Evaluation is a targeted comprehensive assessment of childhood and current symptoms of children, youth, and adults. The Evaluation is specifically designed to diagnose (or rule out) ADD and AD/HD. The evaluation usually consists of the following tests:

Clinical Interview: There is a clinical interview to gain a better picture of you or your child's history and current symptoms.

Initial Assessment: This is the face-to-face session in which a comprehensive history taking and thorough assessment of current symptoms take place. At this meeting, the examinee will complete Brown ADD or Conner 3. For children, parent(s) or caregiver(s) may be given CONNERS 3 or Brown ADD Questionnaires to complete. If the child is in school, Teacher Rating Scales (TRS) may also be provided to get the complete picture of the child behavior at different settings.

Intellectual and Cognitive Abilities Assessment: Depending on the age of the individual WISC-IV (6 and older) or WAIS-IV (16 and older) intelligence test and Woodcock-Johnson III Cognitive Abilities Tests (children and adults) are administered and thoroughly evaluated for intellectual functioning and information processing abilities in several different cognitive domains.

Continuous Performance Test: At the second session, a computer assessment called T.O.V.A. (Test of Variable Attention) may be given, along with other tests of memory, processing speed, and executive functioning.

Consultation of Test Results: Finally, all the data is compiled and your therapist will provide you with the results in the third session. If you do meet criteria for ADD/ADHD, different treatments options will be provided.

- It can help you manage such negative emotions as fear, anger, anxiety, worry, resentment, apprehension, temper tantrum, and lack of empathy.
